

Code of Conduct

Participants in the July 2012 Leadership Academy must abide by the rules of conduct outlined below.

All participants at the Summer Leadership Academy 2012 will:

1. Will be respectful and courteous to classmates, instructors, chaperones and other people who are part of the EduXperience program and all others they come in contact with in the school, residence or tours.
2. Be respectful of shared accommodation space, and school property.
3. Act responsibly while participating in any activities at school or off-site as representatives of the Leadership Academy
4. Not use cell phones during class time

Students under 18 will:

5. Adhere to these rules of conduct during the period they are participating in the EduXperience Summer Leadership Academy (July 1- 28)
6. Participate in all components of the program.
7. Never leave their group without permission and advising their teacher/chaperone where they are going
8. Be punctual for class and activity meeting times; attend daily program; return at pre-arranged times
9. Not participate in high risk activities as determined by EduXperience staff (such as wind surfing, paragliding, bungi jumping, and various other water sports, boating and climbing)
10. Take a swimming test before being participating in water sports
11. Never enter the water (pool or sea) unattended.
12. The use of alcohol or recreational drugs is not permitted at any time.

Failure to adhere to the Code of Conduct can result in being removed from the program at the expense of the participant.
